This class offers guidelines for best practices as a church leader and in mission and ministry in the community and in daily life. *(The United Methodist Book of Discipline recommends that all church Lay Leaders take this class.)*

Leading Prayer This course on public prayer will help you grow in confidence and skill, while encouraging a deeper and more vital prayer life in your personal life.

Spiritual Gifts An ideal resource for those seeking to identify and use their gifts in meaningful ways, this course explores ways in which God's gifts are practical as well as spiritual and how such gifts are connected to the congregational primary tasks of receiving, relating, equipping, and sending.
