Lay Servant Ministries challenges participants to grow in their faith by exploring, learning, and developing skills to serve Christ in their local church and beyond. Ephesians 4:11-12 says “*The gifts he (Christ) gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the Body of Christ.*” Through the Lay Servant Ministries, we seek to fulfill the divine call to build up the Body of Christ through teaching and equipping disciples to serve in their local church and beyond. We are growing disciples!

Basic Lay Servant Class In this introductory course you will be encouraged to discover and employ personal spiritual gifts as God intended and to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in their discipleship. This class offers guidelines for best practices as a church leader and in mission and ministry in the community and in daily life. (*The United Methodist Book of Discipline recommends that all church Lay Leaders take this class.*)

Polity This course gives participants an overview of the structure and organization of The United Methodist Church. A copy of the 2016 Book of Discipline is recommended.

Spiritual Gifts An ideal resource for those seeking to identify and use their gifts in meaningful ways, this course explores ways in which God’s gifts are practical as well as spiritual and how such gifts are connected to the congregational primary tasks of receiving, relating, equipping, and sending.

Stewardship This course helps participants develop a holistic understanding of stewardship.
