ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

This exhibit has been created to glorify God and will feature works that represent the Nature of God, focusing on His inherent qualities, innate character and how He responds to human needs. The works are to be scripturally based. The juried exhibition is open to artists within a 50-mile radius of Woodstock, Georgia. The scripture reference will be on the back of each piece submitted. A pdf catalog of all the works in the exhibition will be available on-line for download. The exhibition will benefit the Forever Fed food ministries (www.foreverfed.org/).

AWARDS

Cash awards totaling \$1,000 will be presented at the exhibition concert on October 3, 2014. All awards are designated by the jurors and are final. All artists accepted into the show are encouraged to attend the Artists Reception. Awards will be presented at the end of the concert.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility

Open to all artists 18 years and older residing within a 50 mile radius of Woodstock, Georgia.

All work must weigh no more than 30 lbs. Plexiglas where applicable is strongly recommended.

All work needs to be clearly identified with a typed label on the back of each piece with your name, title of work, scripture reference, price if for sale or NFS, and contact information.

Categories

2-D painting, drawing, mixed media, graphic, printmaking, and photography.

All work must be suitably framed/mounted or wired for installation. The jurors reserve the right to disqualify any work not suitably presented, or any work appearing not to correspond to the scripture reference. All works accepted for the show must remain in the show until the show ends.

HOW TO ENTER

The non-refundable entry fee is \$25.00 (\$20.00 students) per application (may submit up to three works per application). Additional pieces beyond the initial entry fee will be \$5.00 per entry.

All work must be in jpg or pdf form. The file name should be as follows: Entry form number: (1,2, or 3) –artist's name-title of work. Example: 1_JohnSmith_BigPainting.jpg. Each file size should be less than 1MB in size and a maximum of 1,500 pixels width or height (which ever is larger).

TO CONSIDER

Each artist has the opportunity to donate an original piece or print for a benefit auction. The auction results will be announced at the end of the concert. It will be a tax write off and all proceeds go to the Forever Fed food ministry.

JURY RESULTS

Juror selections will be emailed back to artists September 30, 2014.

DELIVERY OF WORK

The work can be delivered Friday, Sept 12 from 3:00-7:00 or Saturday, Sept 13 from 10:00 -2:00.

PICKING UP YOUR WORK

Work unclaimed within 30 days becomes property of Hillside Methodist Church.

The work can be picked up Friday, January 9, 2015 from 3:00-7:00 or Saturday, January 10, 2015 from 10:00 -2:00

While Hillside United Methodist Church personnel will do everything possible to assure the safety of the artwork, we are not to be held responsible or liable for lost, damaged, or stolen items while on church premises. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
