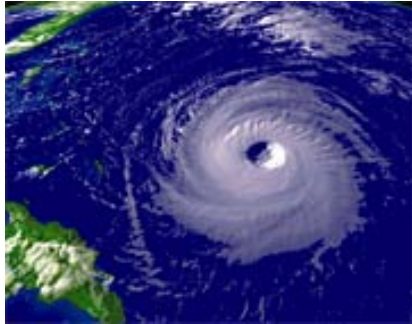

A Call for Help

Hurricane Isabel brought havoc and widespread destruction over North Carolina, Virginia, Maryland, Delaware and the District of Columbia. Not only were buildings damaged and trees downed, but also flooding and power outages were commonplace across the mid-Eastern coastline and several miles inland.

Both Bishops Joe Pennel of Virginia and Marion Edwards of North Carolina reported significant destruction in their areas. A request has been issued

from Bishop Edwards asking for recovery help. Volunteers are asked to e-mail merci@nccumc.org or call 1-888-440-9167.

The flood buckets collected in our remembrance of 9/11 have made their way to the scene through the United Methodist Committee On Relief (UMCOR). Future buckets will be sent directly to North Carolina and Virginia. Approximately \$6,000 has been received at the United Methodist Center and these supplies will be on the way shortly.

As well as the flood buckets ([click here to see the list of items to be included](#)), health kits ([click here for contents](#)) are also needed. Brooms and mops are in demand. Indeed, work teams for tree and debris removal would bring a helping hand and encouragement.

With UMCOR's commitment to staying until the job is done, it is anticipated that rebuilding teams with plumbing, carpentry, and electrical skills will be required as soon as the assessment and cleanup phase is completed. Already, emergency grants have been approved from UMCOR. The agency is receiving money for the hurricane relief through "Hurricanes 2003," Advance No. 982438. Each local church is urged to take an offering to assist persons and churches in the path of Isabel. Checks may be sent to Keith Cox, North Georgia Conference Treasurer.
