Capable and Willing to Respond

The tragedy of Hurricane Katrina has reminded us of the critical nature of helping agencies and ministries to be ready. Regular updates concerning needs of persons effected by the storm are being sent via e-mail and published on the North Georgia Conference web page (www.ngumc.org). Your response will make a tremendous difference to persons who lack hope or exist in dangerous conditions.

One ministry of the Conference, which has steadily and effectively been prepared to serve persons, is Wesley Community Centers, Inc. At Camp Wesley weeks this summer, 188 children and youth learned valuable lessons concerning our faith. Most campers were referred by social service agencies and attended on camperships because their families could not afford to send them. Each weekday, dozens of senior citizens enjoy the activities at Bethlehem Community Center. They receive hot meals, get help with social services, exercise, do crafts, participate in Bible studies, and go on field trips. Some of the seniors take advantage of home repairs (i.e., roof repairs, painting, yard work, ramps, etc.) done by Project Extend volunteers.

A large percentage of the monies required to carry on the aforementioned ministries is raised through the Wesley Walk for Others. This year over 1,000 United Methodists are expected to make the six-mile trek around Stone Mountain on October 22nd. Walkers are asked to raise pledge monies. You are invited to participate by contacting Wesley Community Centers at 404-872-0086 or by going to www.wesleycenters.org.

Out of numerous stories of people who have made the hike each year, is that of Garth Davidson, known as "T. G." who completed the last twenty walks. He recruited and inspired teams of youth and adults from Bethany Church in Smyrna. Because of his efforts, the church raised the largest donations for its size several times. Last October, his family urged the 82 year old to forego the long walk but he persisted, raised \$500, and completed the six miles. It was to be his last such effort before his death on December 3rd. In memory of "T. G." a host of family members and friends from four states will raise donations and join the walkers.
