Dealing with Grief

For over ten years, Judy Wolfe served as Oncology Chaplain at Scottish Rite Hospital in Atlanta. This spouse of John Wolfe, President of the Methodist Hour and Pastor of Birmingham Church, is the mother of three and grandmother of seven. After graduation from Candler School of Theology, she took on this sometimes heartrending ministry to patients and families. Few people have participated in and known the dynamics of grief in multiple experiences as has Judy.

On Tuesday, October 14, and Wednesday, October 15, she will offer two seminars at Simpsonwood in the North Georgia Room of the Rollins Center. The first is entitled "Helping Yourself and Others Who Grieve." Moves, divorce, promotions, job losses, death, relationship changes, and retirement are but a few situations that call for grieving. Grief-avoidance is rampant. It leaves some depressed. Others struggle relationally. Even some turn to chemical dependence. Learning how to grieve and help others in the process enables healing to occur.

The Wednesday seminar bears the title "Children: The Forgotten Grievers." Unresolved grief can produce in children a variety of responses which range from relational difficulties to learning disorders to depression to suicidal tendencies to violent behavior and others. The goal is to teach the participant to deal with losses in his or her own childhood or help children and teens who are dealing with these traumatic situations.
