On Saturday, October 28, over 1,200 North Georgians are expected to “give feet to the faith of the church” during the 24th Annual Wesley Walk for Others sponsored by Wesley Community Centers, Inc. Proceeds from this fundraiser will benefit the Bethlehem Senior Center, 200 at-risk children and youth through Camp Wesley, and Project Extend, a home repair program for low-income older adults.

“Our event kicks-off at 7:30 a.m. in the parking lot of Stone Mountain First Church. We will begin with a blessing and some stretching exercises,”

says Sue Raymond, volunteer coordinator for the Wesley Walk for Others. “Brian Jordan of the Atlanta Braves is serving as our Grand Marshal. He will cut the ribbon and then lead the way on a pleasant 6.2 mile course that takes walkers around Stone Mountain during the colorful height of fall foliage.”

Churches, scout troops, youth groups, and families alike will have the opportunity to exercise, enjoy food, fun, and fellowship, revel in God’s majesty, and experience the satisfaction that comes from supporting a United Methodist-related ministry that has been working to meet the needs of people since 1902. Walkers who raise \$10 will receive a complimentary T-shirt. Persons who raise \$100 or more will receive a T-shirt and a coordinating baseball hat. And if that’s not enough—the walker and the pastor of the church who raises the most money in the Conference will each receive two free tickets for travel on AirTran Airways.
