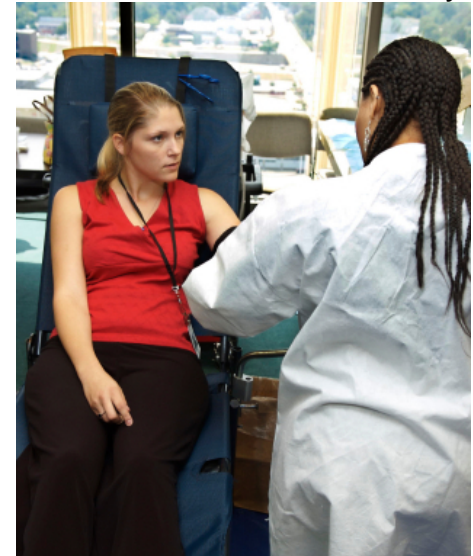

Yet, the impact over the past two years seemed to scream the need to find a way. With a few minor adjustments, the event will return on Wednesday, June 13, from 12 to 3 p.m.

Thanks to the careful planning of Carol Rymer and her committee, a variety of projects are ready for persons of diverse interests and activity levels. They range from a Red Cross blood drive to helping poor, disabled, or elderly people with home repairs to making gifts for hospice patients to neighborhood clean-up to writing letters to missionaries and to those soldiers in the military abroad to praying for the city of Athens and to about 20 other expressions. A new event is the "Great Day of Service 5K Run/Walk" which will begin at 6:30 a.m. on Wednesday. The proceeds from this race will benefit the "Nothing But Nets" campaign and help save lives of Africans by placing with families across the continent treated bed nets to protect
